

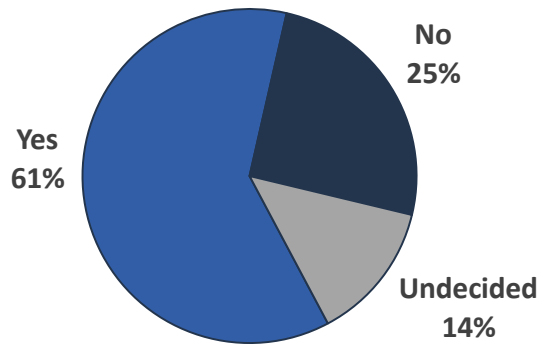

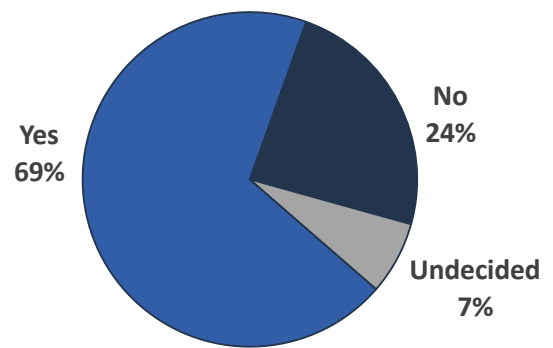


2020 Legislative Survey Results

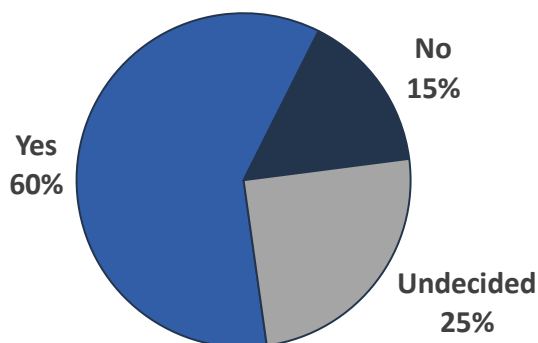
1. Do you believe the state should automatically expunge a person's non-violent criminal record if they have served their sentence and remained out of trouble for multiple years?



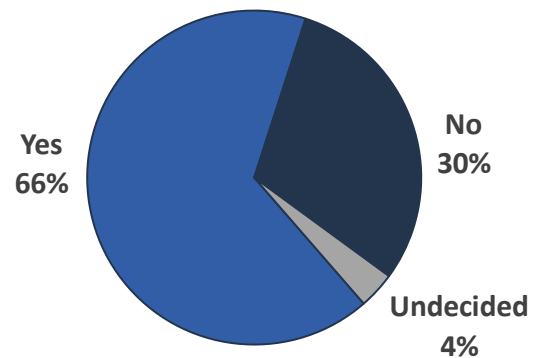

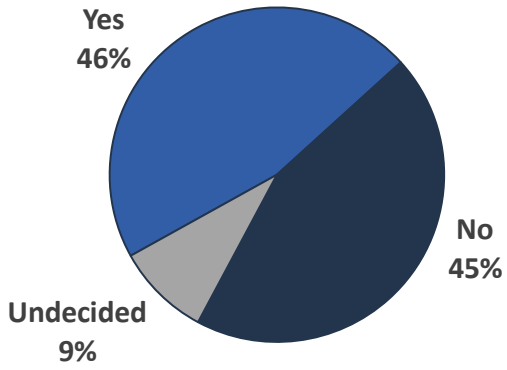

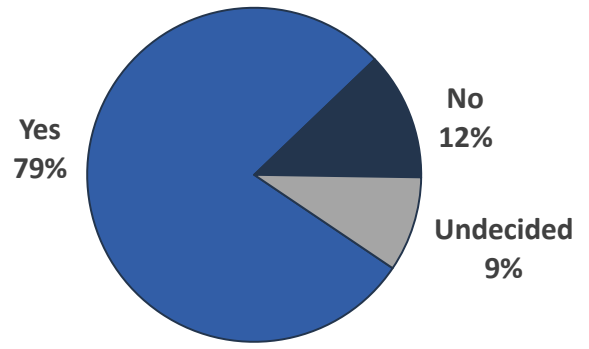
4. Would you support raising the age to purchase tobacco to 21?
