

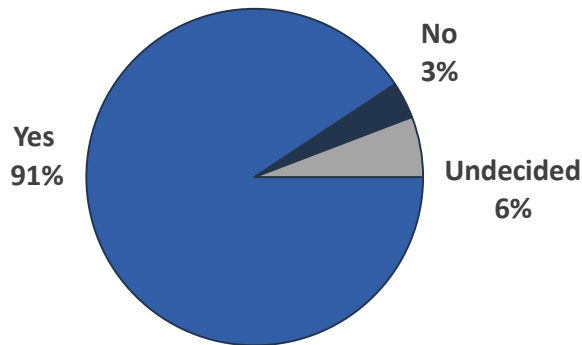

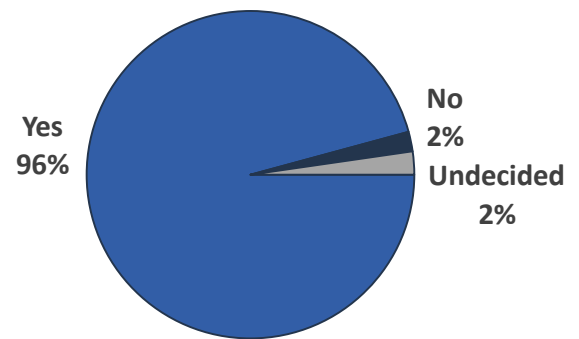


## 2020 Legislative Survey Results

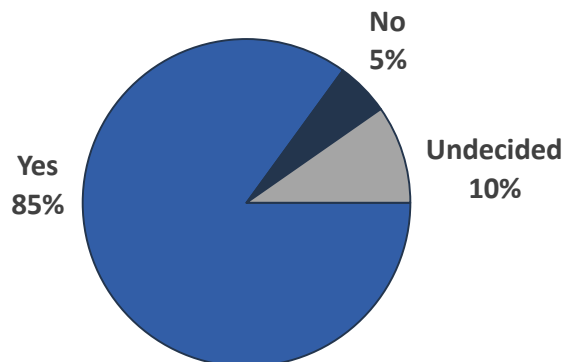
1. Should school performance measures be adjusted so there is less emphasis on high-stakes testing, and greater emphasis on college- or career-readiness and student outcomes?



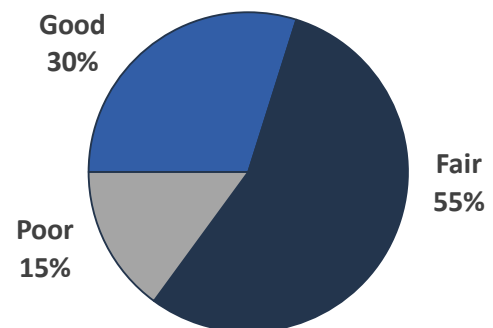

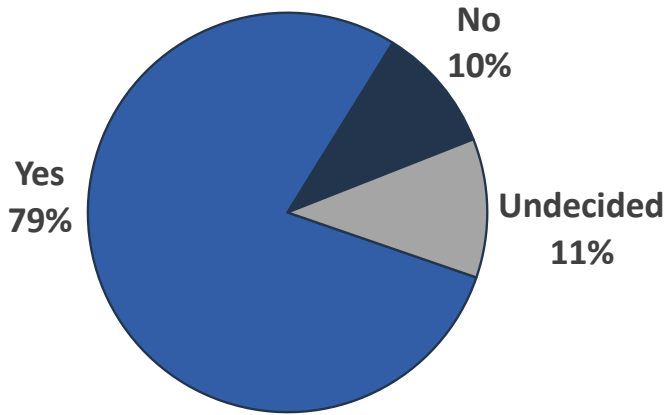

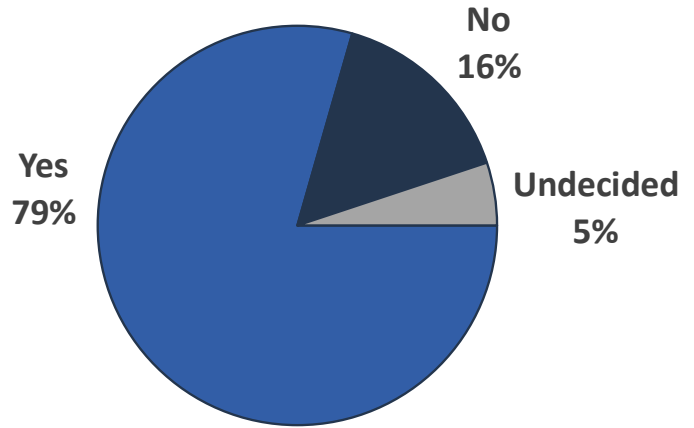
4. How would you rate the local roads in your community?
