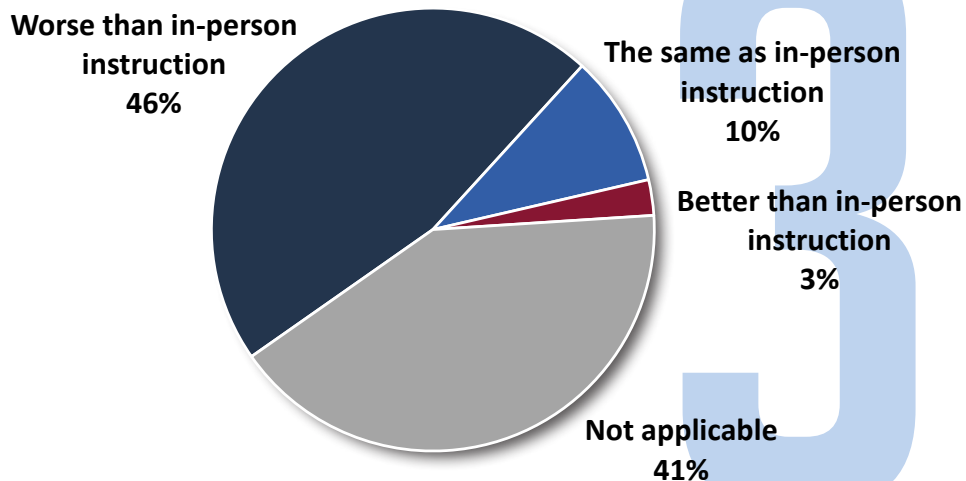

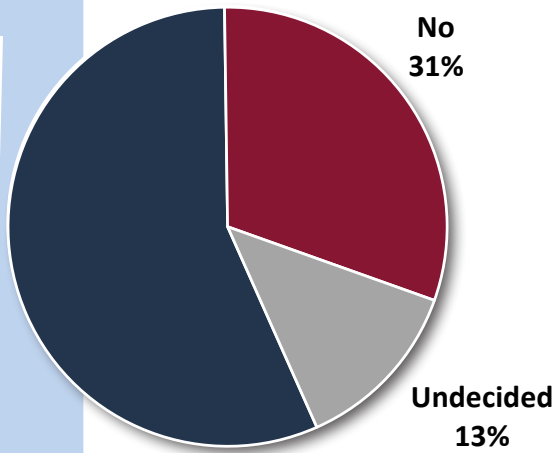


2. Do you support increasing the income eligibility for Indiana's CHOICE scholarships, giving more low- and middle-income families the option to send their children to the school that best meets their needs?

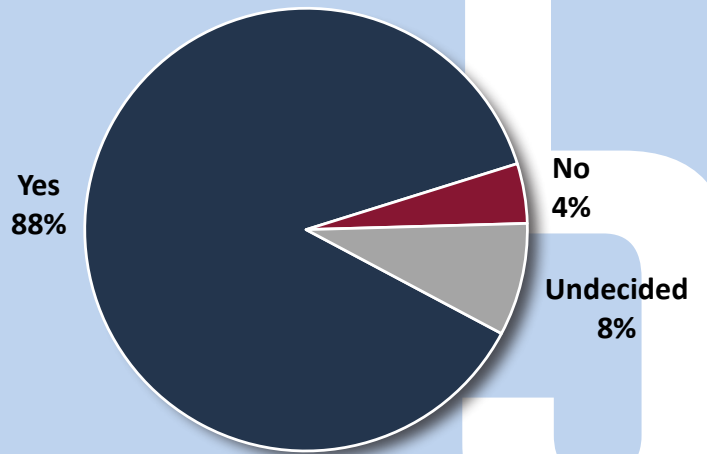
