





Would you support changing Indiana law to allow the carryout sale of alcohol on Sundays?










Do you support a state constitutional amendment establishing a nonpartisan commission to draw legislative and congressional districts?








Do you support making it more difficult for law enforcement to seize private property, such as cash, an automobile or house, which they believe was used in the commission of a crime?


Should Hoosiers be automatically registered to vote when they obtain a driver's license?






Do you believe that Hoosier adults should have the ability to legally buy and possess any hemp-derived or cannabidiol (CBD) product?
