Would you support allowing the carryout sale of cold beer by retailers other than liquor stores, such as grocery stores and convenience marts?

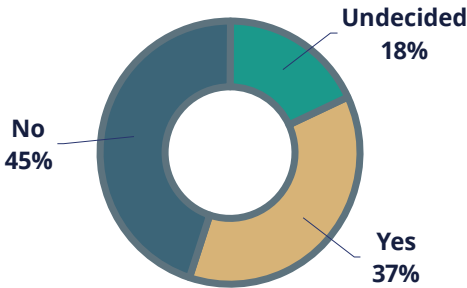
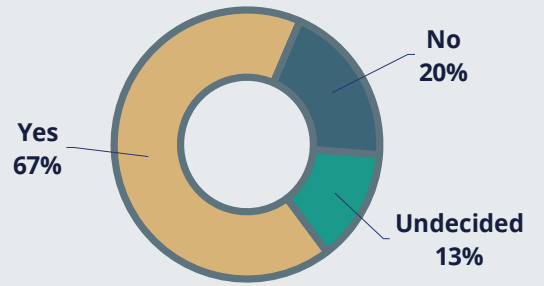

Should Indiana do more to ensure that every community has access to fast, reliable broadband?



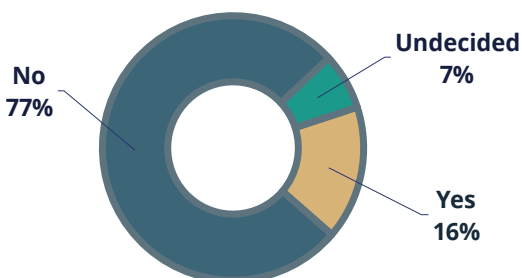
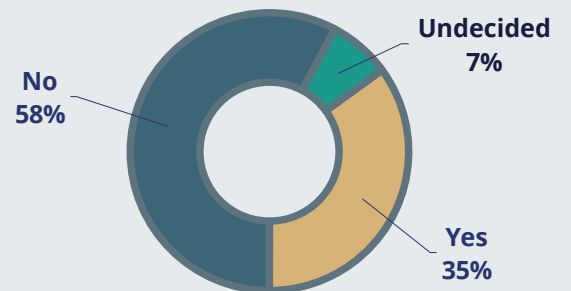
Do you believe that our K-12 education system is doing an adequate job preparing our students for college and/or the workforce?

The United States has been shifting from a manufacturing-driven economy to a service-driven economy, which has resulted in unpredictable and declining sales tax – a major source of state revenue.
