Indiana provides a \$100 tax credit to educators for out-of-pocket school supply expenses. Do you believe this credit should be increased?

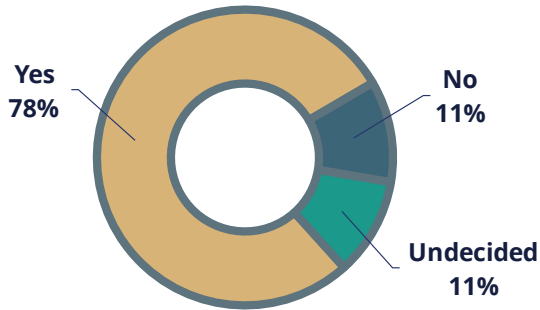
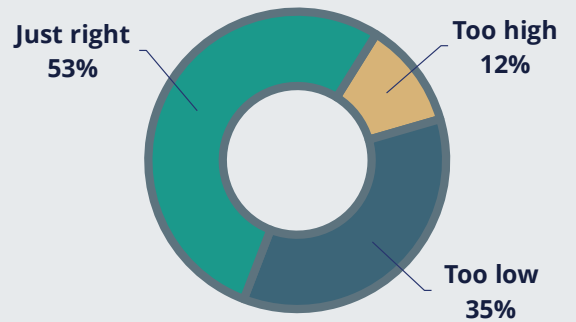

Do you support allocating a portion of state funding to local schools based on performance outcomes?



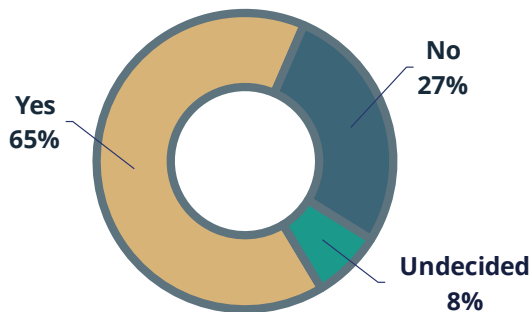
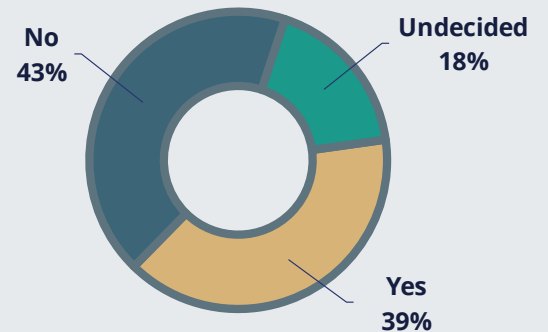
