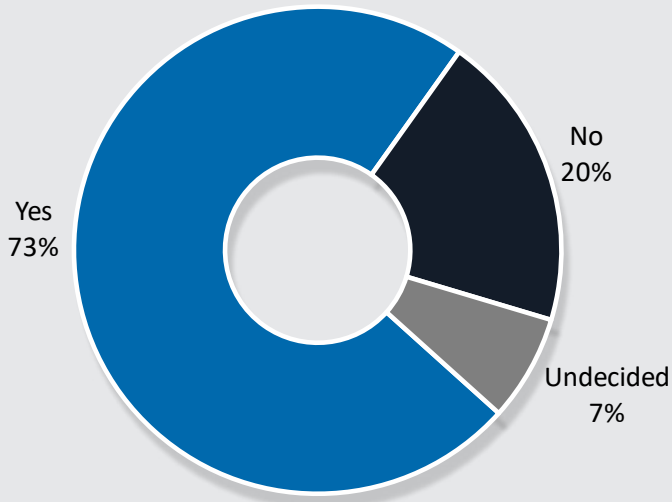


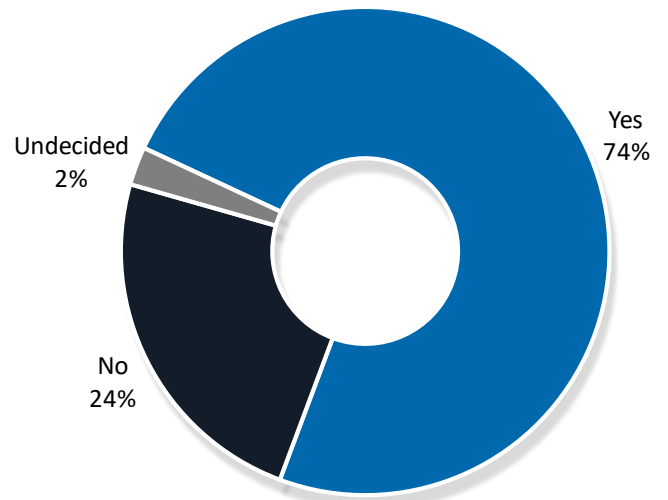

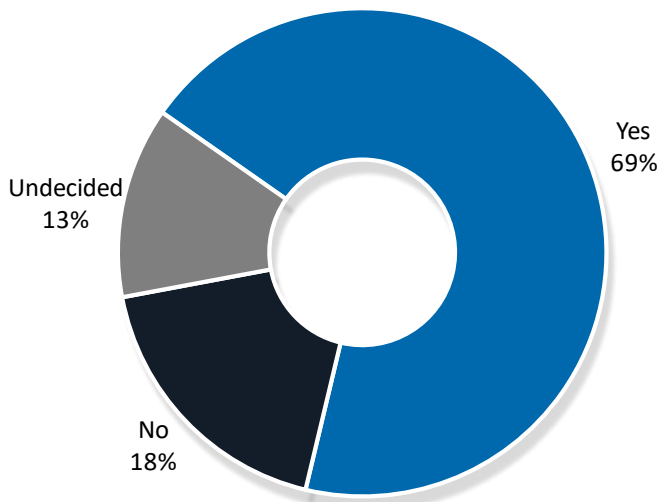
1. Would you support raising the age to purchase tobacco to 21?



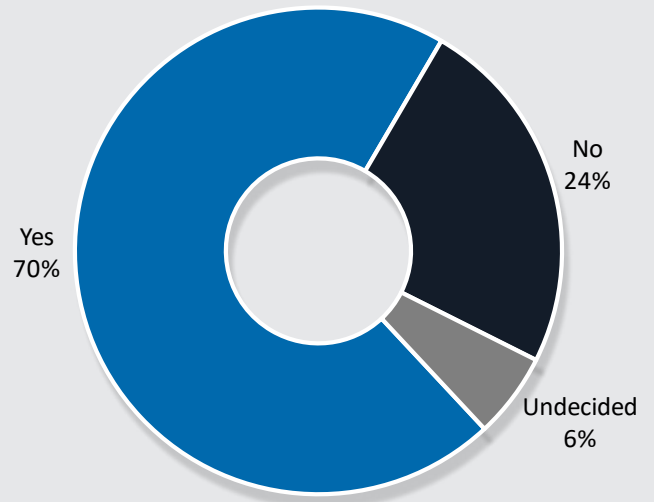
2. Would you support raising the state tax on tobacco?



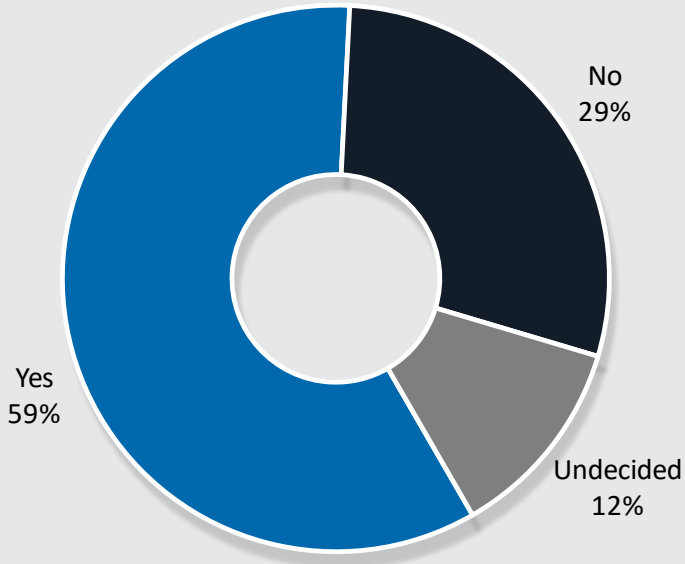
3. Should the state increase the availability of online classes and distance-learning opportunities offered to high school students so that they can benefit from subject areas and teaching styles their school may not be able to provide?



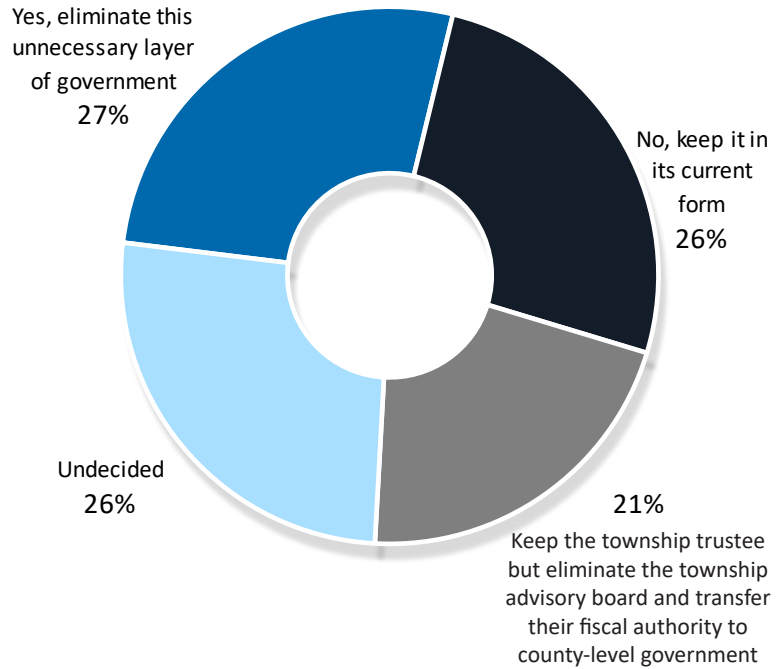

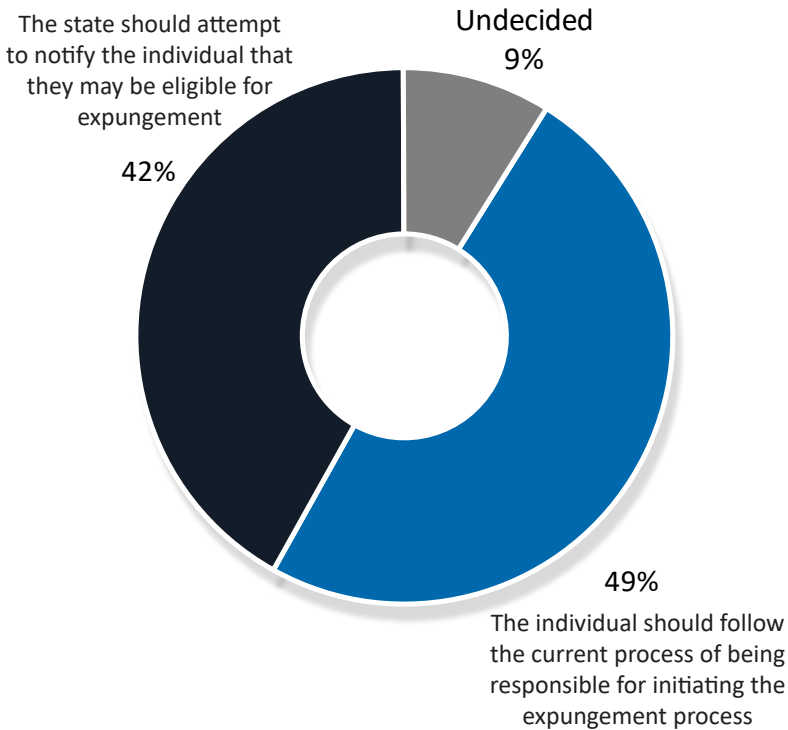
**5. Would you support exempting military pensions from state income taxes?**
