



LEGISLATIVE ACCOMPLISHMENTS 2021 INDIANA HOUSE REPUBLICANS END OF SESSION REPORT

SUPPORT A RESPONSIBLE BUDGET, KEY INVESTMENTS



- Support a fiscally responsible state budget and invest in key priorities while maintaining prudent reserves and AAA credit rating (HEA1001) ✓
- Establish a new grant program to target Indiana's most critical health challenges (HEA1007) ✓
- Expand rural broadband to help close the digital divide for Hoosier students, workers and employers (HEA1001) ✓

HELP SMALL BUSINESSES, HOOSIER WORKERS & INDIANA'S ECONOMY



- Provide civil liability protections related to COVID-19 for businesses, schools, health care entities and others (HEA1002/SEA1) ✓
- Extend and strengthen an existing small business grant program and give priority to the hospitality industry (HEA1004) ✓
- Support low-income Hoosier workers by increasing the earned income tax credit, and removing barriers for TANF recipients who enroll in work-based learning and apprenticeship programs (HEA1009) ✓

INVEST IN HOOSIER STUDENTS, TEACHERS & SCHOOLS



- Fully fund all K-12 public school students for the 2020-21 school year, whether they attend classes in-person or virtually due to COVID-19 (SEA2) ✓
- Help more families exercise school choice (HEA1001) ✓
- Create a one-time grant to help school-aged children combat learning loss as a result of the pandemic (HEA1008) ✓

SUPPORT LAW ENFORCEMENT, BOOST ACCOUNTABILITY & TRANSPARENCY IN POLICING



- Invest in law enforcement training facilities and programs, and create a one-time grant to help pay for body cameras (HEA1001) ✓
- Require full employment record sharing between police departments to identify bad actors (HEA1006) ✓
- Provide additional flexibility to the Indiana Law Enforcement Training Board to address significant officer misconduct (HEA1006) ✓
- Require de-escalation training for new recruits and current officers (HEA1006 – Signed into law) ✓
